 - System largely based on private enterprise

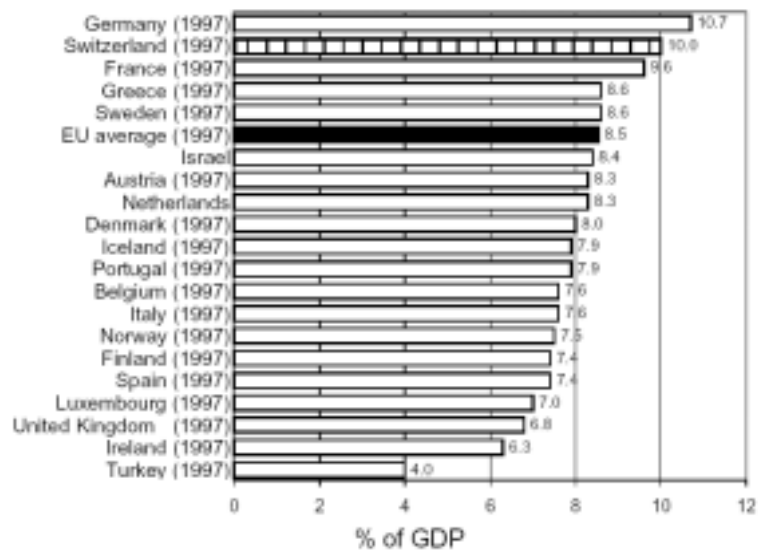

- Decisions and responsibilities are shared between :
 - The federal government
 - The 26 cantons
 - The municipalities

Federal Healthcare Reform

- New Federal Health Insurance Law LAMal (1996)
 - Mandatory basic health insurance
 - Liberty of choice between insurance companies
 - Mandatory cantonal strategic planning of healthcare infrastructure
 - Encouragement of competition within the healthcare system

Canton Vaud Healthcare Reform

- New Orientations of Health Policy NOPS (1997)
 - Five to eight networks of care
 - Service provision contracts between cantonal authorities and networks of care
 - Application of funding directives in accordance with the LAMal
 - Information provision to the population

- What is the level of nurses' knowledge concerning the principles of healthcare reforms in Canton Vaud ?
- Are there knowledge differences relating to employment setting, nurses' roles and level of education ?

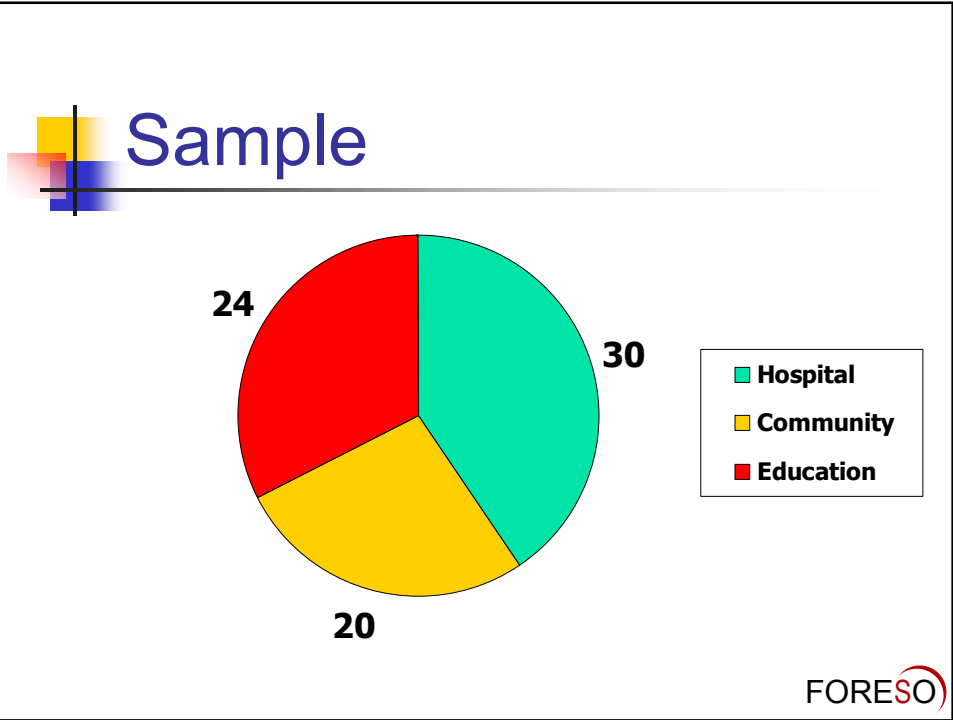


Nurses' population in Canton Vaud

- 5000 nurses
 - Public hospitals : 50%
 - Private or specialized hospitals : 20%
 - Community : 11-12%
 - Nursing homes : 11-12%
 - Other : 6 - 8%

- Mean age
 - 42.34, SD 7.8
 - Mean work experience
 - 17.8, SD 7.7
 - Position
 - 38 % nurses occupying managerial positions
 - Education
 - 23 % nurses holding academic degree

 - 25 Items regarding LAMal
 - 15 Items regarding NOPS

 - Total knowledge
 - LAMal
 - NOPS
 - Certainty scale

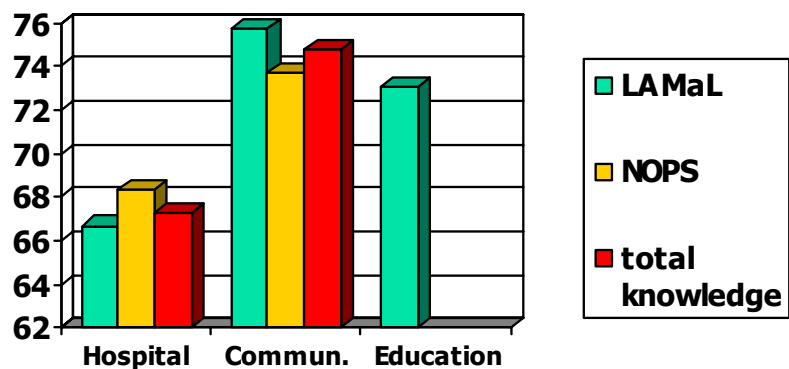

- Proportion of correct answers :
 - LAMaL 72 %
 - NOPS 71 %
 - Total knowledge 71.5 %

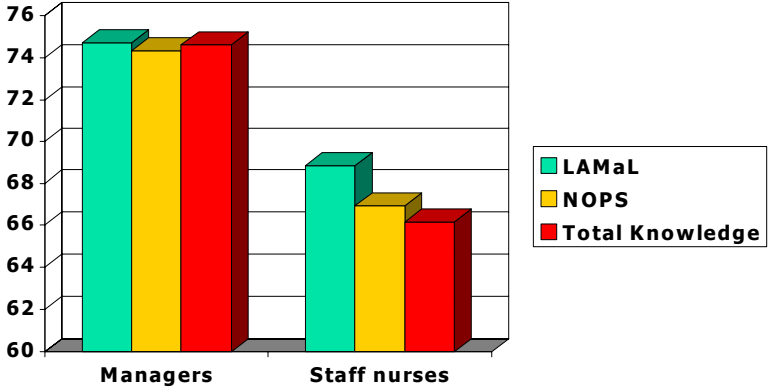

Percentage of Correct Responses by Employment Setting



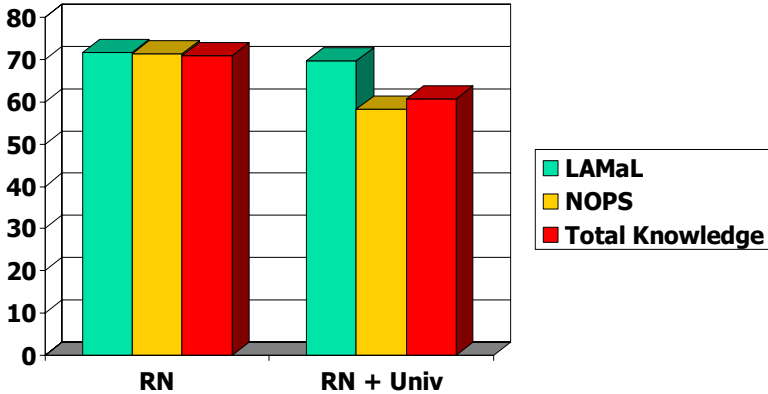
